

# West Virginia: Unemployment Benefits for Those Affected by COVID-19

#### **Description of Program and Relief**

On March 19, 2020, Governor Jim Justice issued an executive order directing WorkForce West Virginia and the West Virginia Department of Commerce to provide unemployment benefits to individuals affected by COVID-19 to the maximum extent permitted by federal law.

The executive order allows WorkForce to:

- Waive the normal one-week waiting period for unemployment benefits
- Waive the able and available work requirement
- Waive the work search requirement
- Grant unemployment benefits to eligible individuals who are requested by a medical professional or employer to be isolated or quarantined even if they are not diagnosed.

#### **Dates Available**

March 19, 2020, and ongoing for the duration of the Governor's declared State of Emergency due to COVID-19

#### **Eligibility Requirements/Restrictions**

The executive order indicates that individuals who are separated from employment, have had their hours of employment reduced, or are prevented from working due to either a documented medical condition caused by COVID-19 or due to communicable disease control measures related to COVID-19 are eligible for unemployment benefits to the maximum extent permitted by federal law.
