Oklahoma: Business Request for Designation as an Essential Business During COVID-19 Closure

Description of Program and Relief

The Governor of Oklahoma has issued Oklahoma Executive Order 2020-07, which requires all non-essential businesses located in a county experiencing community spread of COVID-19 to close. Many businesses are already classified as essential. No further action is required if an industry is classified as essential. If not already considered essential, business owners may request their industry be considered for inclusion as an essential business.
